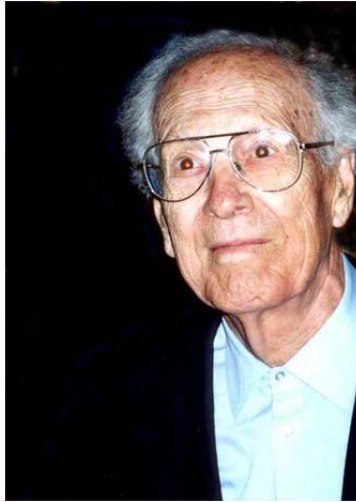


# Howard Britten
