He loved to be involved and was a member of many Clubs, Associations and Societies. He also served on the Calgary Exhibition and Stampede Board for several years.

He was introduced to our Club by Gardie Shaw and inducted on May 31, 1978 with the classification "Oil Land Leasing." He served the Club as a Director during the Rotary years 1983-1984 and 1984-1985.

Stu and Pamela attended the Rotary International Convention in Nice, France in 1995 and along with several other couples from our Club enjoyed a "Best of Italy" tour before the Convention. Stu's wit and dry sense of humor kept the tour entertained.
